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FCA encourages summer reading. Our purpose is to read for enlightenment and enjoyment.

This year we are asking students to all read the same book (if you have not already read it in the past) which will allow them to start the school year with a book unit on the summer reading book.

All 7th grade students should read:

The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by CS Lewis

IXL

We are also asking students to do math and English IXL work over the summer. IXL is an adaptive learning platform that allows us to identify students strengths and holes and allows each student to work on their areas of weaknesses or gaps.

All students entering into Grade 7 will enter the IXL arena and complete the diagnostic for English and Math. Then all students need to complete the necessary lessons and to earn an IXL score of at least a 700. Students entering 7th grade are expected to have an arena score of at least a 700 in both math and English by the time school starts.

This work will take each student a different amount of time depending on strengths and weaknesses. Once a student has obtained the needed scores, they are welcome to continue working on new skills.
